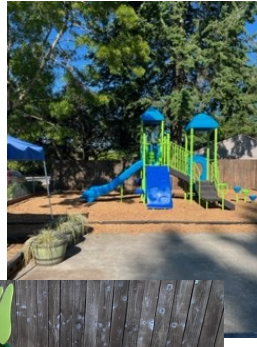

Play...Teach...Love

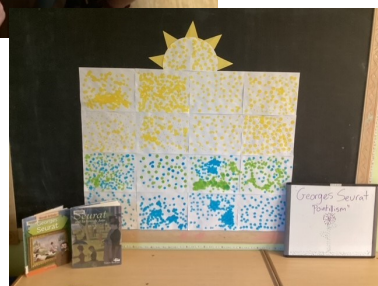
