The best thing about being a preschool teacher is teaching them something new and watching the excitement on their faces and their eyes light up with excitement.

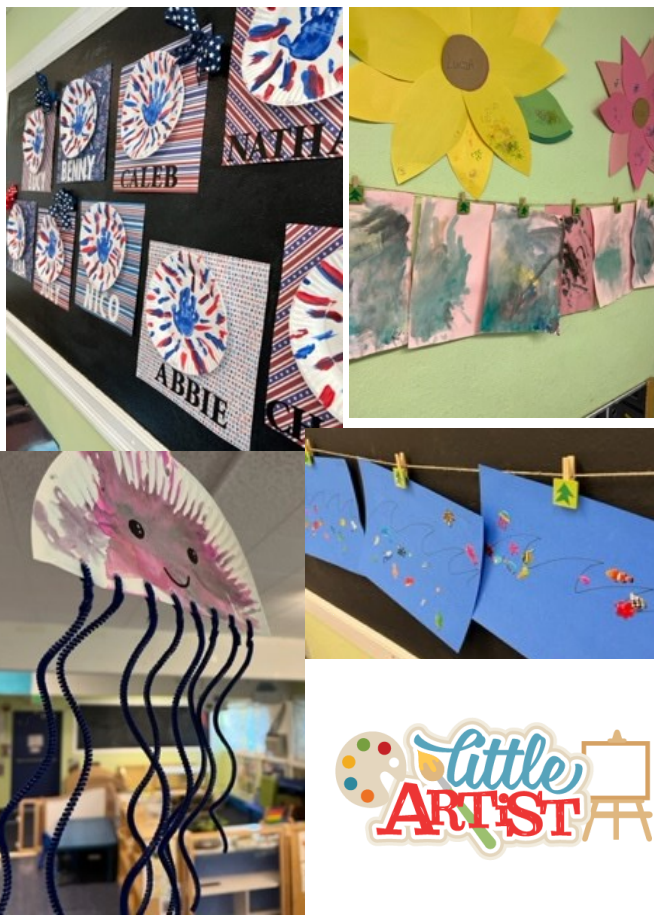
Everyday is a special day of learning, sharing and smiles
