Indoor Snowflakes

Ingredients:

- Cookie Tray
- Cornstarch
- Baking Soda
- Water
- Cookie Cutters, Pinecones, Plastic Snowflakes

Directions:

1. Pour equal amounts of cornstarch and baking soda onto tray.
2. Mix baking soda and cornstarch with your fingers.
3. Add just enough water so that when you squeeze some of the mixture in your Hands, you can form a ball.
4. Gently loosen any clumps until your fake snow looks just like real snow.
