





LPW Bean Soup

Bacon, a few strips

Onion medium, diced

15 Bean Soup Mix, the whole bag

1 qt of chicken broth

1 Can diced Tomatoes

Ham chunks



Soak the beans over night, or at least 8 hours. After the beans are done soaking, fry some bacon in a pan. We use a pound for the whole school. When the bacon is cooked, chop it up, then sauté the onion and put it in a big pot with the bacon. Add the chicken broth, diced tomatoes, beans, and ham chunks. Bring to a boil then reduce to simmer. Simmer the soup for about 1-2 hours. If it gets too thick add a little water. When the beans are soft the soup is done! Sometimes the cook will put carrots in the soup, which makes it tasty! The kids like to eat the soup with corn bread.
