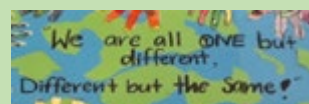

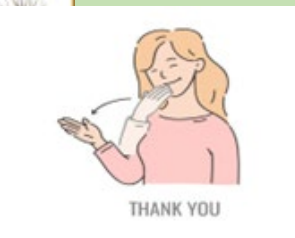

in the breeze.



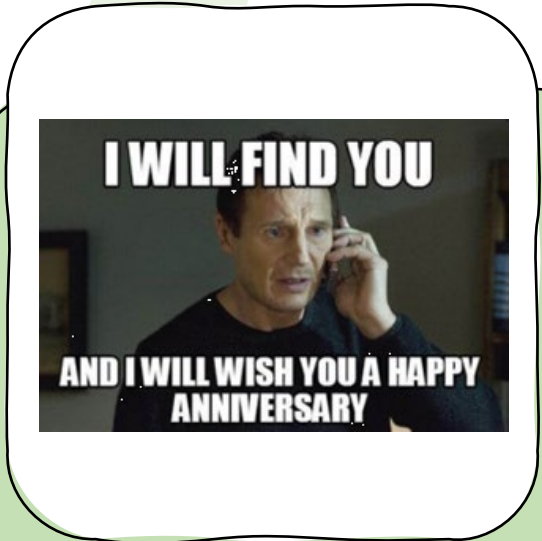
## Play...Teach...Love
